Council AGM Report + April 2019 / March 2020

Council members met ten times during this period, including one meeting with the Archdeacon on the 14th of September. On top of these 'regular' meetings Council met also for a Day Away on the 22nd of June.

Meetings began and ended with prayer and then a time of 'landing', answering the questions: 'What significant events are happening in our personal lives?' and 'What could we see God doing in our church?'

Topics discussed during the year:

- In every Council meeting we discuss last month's finance report and vote to accept it.
- What kind of church are we, where do we want to be; what does God want for us?
- During this year we discussed several times the topic of 'Youth Ministry Pastoral Support'.
- We have discussed several options to move to another venue, but without practical consequences. We stay in touch with other churches to see what come available.
- On Away Day we discussed: 'The Anglican structure of our church' and Who are we as church?
- We are considering to change the seating in our church.
- We are complying as well as we can with all the safeguarding rules of the Diocese. We can apply for free VOG applications.
- We discussed the budget for 2020: 2.7% increase compared with 2019.
- We discussed Communion Measures in the light of Covid-19.

Decisions made:

- Next year (2020) we will have AGM on one day. Date: 29th of March.
- We have let the Diocesan Safeguarding Officer know that we are not satisfied with the way they have handled matters; we have our fears for future matters.
- We have made a laptop available for KidZchurch.
- We have agreed to pay the standard payments to our mission partners.
- We decide to ask the welcome team to function as ushers during Communion so people don't queue up in the middle of church.

- We have decided to ask the Fire Brigade about rules for linkage of chairs;
 we have done that three times but without an answer.
- Our published ANBI-status has been kept up to date (on website).
- The amount from the TYDE fundraising was €625 and has gone out to The Mission to Seafarers.
- We keep paying rent for Gill's House in Sri Lanka per six months as long as necessary. This is part of FOMT allocation.
- We made the building available to De Pracht Zomervakantiekoor; they payed rent and we shared the costs of piano tuning.
- Notices at the end of the service should be made known before the service.
- Council decided on proposal of FOMT to give the money from the Christmas Market to Joe and Anna Beswick for their mission trip to South-Africa.
- We decided to pursue all related issues with intent to purchase a church building in Eindhoven. The building was sold to a third party with first rights.
- · We updated our hardware for backing up our website.
- We stopped working with Right Now Media because they do not work according to GDPR.
- We decided to take part in the Deanery Day; Francis (safeguarding), Rajesh, Joan (treasurer) and Jan (secretary) went.
- We work with the new Safeguarding Policy of the Diocese; lots of responsibility now lies with the chaplaincy.
- We have asked our landlord if our church building is still for sale.
- Pamela Armstrong worked in 2019 as Youth Ministry Pastoral Support Person; the work was covered with a 'vrijwilligersbijdrage'.
- We decided that Pamela will go on with her work in 2020 under the same conditions; in the second half of the year her payment will be evaluated.
- We have decided to ask the Diocese for project money on our project for Youth Ministry Pastoral Support; we made a budget of €8000, of which we can get 50%. The Diocese has agreed to this.
- We have decided to pay the full amount to the Diocesan Common Fund for 2019. For 2020 we have to make a new decision.
- We have bought two table tennis tables as equipment for Youth Ministries.
- We asked the Waalre Town Council to repair the pavement at our front door. That worked!
- After extended discussion we made a decision on the 'Role Description of the Youth Ministry Pastoral Support Person; We agreed to Pamela Armstrong in this position. An Agreement was signed.
- We decided to go for the use of paper towels in our restrooms.
- We decided to buy a new vacuum cleaner.
- We decided as a temporarily measure to offer the bread for Communion and to offer the chalice but let no one dip bread or drink wine.
