

TRINITY CHURCH EINDHOVEN

The Church Representation Rules (1995) enable a person to be enrolled if she/he is baptised, sixteen years or upwards and declares themselves – "to be a member in good standing of a Church which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and also prepared to declare himself to be a member of the Church of England having habitually attended public worship in the parish during a period of six months prior to enrolment." Making this declaration also confers eligibility to stand for election to the decision-making bodies of the Church of England.
