Report for 2020 Annual General Meeting

Trinity Church Eindhoven has received of God's Grace and so we choose to give five percent of all income for furthering The Lord's Kingdom on earth beyond Eindhoven. The Funding Outreach and Mission Team (FOMT) oversees this giving into mission, charity and discipleship withing the framework approved by TCE Council.

FOMT is made up of Council and non-council Trinity Church members. In this last year we lost the service of Aarnoud Dommisse who moved on from TCE. We are looking to grow our team this year, please consider joining us. We meet several times a year in prayer for our mission partners and for discernment over funding.

FOMT supports three families around the world that are long term mission partners:

The Garvey- Williams Family in Buncrana, Northern Ireland

The Kroze family (who were to visit us in May but have had to cancel) in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia

The Olive family evangelizing with Youth for Christ in Pondicherry, India

FOMT also continues to support the Gill family, a refugee from Pakistan in exile in Sri Lanka. This support consists of rental payment for their temporary home and a cash collection in the church of basic stable for this family of six.

Another joy has been to help the church support Joe and Anna Beswick in their call to mission through fund rising activities
