

## **'FOMT' [Funding, Outreach & Missions Team] Report on 2019 for 2020 Annual General Meeting**

We have received of God's Grace and so we choose to give five percent of all income for furthering The Lord's Kingdom. The Funding Outreach and Mission Team (FOMT) oversees this giving into mission, charity and discipleship within the framework approved by TCE Council. FOMT is made up of Council and non-council Trinity Church members. Council approves all giving.

In this last year we lost the service of Aarnoud Dommissie who moved on from TCE. We are looking to grow our team this year, please consider joining us. We meet several times a year in prayer for our mission partners and for discernment over funding.

FOMT supports three families that are long term mission partners with Trinity Church:

The Garvey- Williams Family in Bunclrana, Northern Ireland

The Kroze family (who had planned to visit us in May but cancelled due to travel restrictions) in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia

The Olive family, evangelizing with Youth for Christ in Pondicherry, India.

Each of our mission partners and Hwee Chong, a Trinity member serving on an OM ship, received 300 euros as an additional Christmas gift in December 2019. As stated in the Treasurer's report, Hwee Chong is supported by many members of the wider TCE community, with these donations going directly to Operation Mobilisation.

FOMT also continues to support the Gill family, a refugee from Pakistan in exile in Sri Lanka. This support consists of rental payment for their temporary home and a cash collection in the church of basic stable for this family of six.

Another joy has been to help the church support Joe and Anna Beswick in their call to mission through fund raising activities, especially the Christmas fair.

As in past years, FOMT was happy to recommend giving to the Bishop's Advent appeal.

A small mercy fund given through FOMT to assisted a Church member with transport costs to attend Sunday Church services.

The Treasurer's report gives a comprehensive breakdown of all FOMT allocations in 2019.
