We meet every Sunday at 10.30 am (Walk in at 10.15am). After service, there will be refreshments and fellowship.

Fellowship & Monthly Lunch

In addition to refreshments after each service, we hold a monthly shared lunch, typically on the second Sunday of the month. Everyone is invited to bring a dish to share. These meals are a wonderful way to build relationships, enjoy good food, and experience the joy of community—because few things bring people together like sharing a meal.

Harrison Chinnakumar, Pastor

Originally from Tamil Nadu, India, Pastor Harrison has served in mission and pastoral ministry across India, Bangladesh, Kuwait, and Dubai. After coming to faith in 1981 and sensing God's call to ministry, he joined the Indian Missionary Society and later trained at Union Biblical Seminary in Pune.

His journey has included church planting, youth work, theological training, and interfaith dialogue. He was collated as a Canon of St. Christophers' Cathedral, Bahrain in 2021. Most recently, he served as the chaplain of Holy Trinity Church, Dubai before joining Trinity Church Eindhoven.

Pastor Harrison is married to Susan, and together they are passionate about building up the church both in ministry and mission. He is currently pursuing a PhD in Intercultural Studies and is excited to serve alongside the Trinity family.

Pamela Armstrong, Youth Coordinator

Originally from Northern Ireland, Pamela came to faith at a young age and later trained in Youth and Community Work. Her heart for mission led her to serve families in inner-city London, where she met her husband, Andrew. Now settled in the Netherlands with their three energetic children, Pamela balances family life with part-time work as an English teacher.

A long-time member of Trinity Church since 2002, Pamela plays a key role in supporting our youth ministry. She helps coordinate youth groups (1Tim4:12 and TYDE), offering care to both our young people and their leaders in this vital pastoral role.



Various Ministries in TCE

The Welcome Team greets everyone with warmth on Sunday mornings—especially newcomers. They help with seating, guide during communion, and create a smooth, respectful experience. It's a great way to connect and help build a welcoming community.

The Coffee Team sets up early and serves drinks and snacks after the service, creating a warm, welcoming space for connection and fellowship.

The Funding and Outreach Mission Team (FOMT) guides resource allocation for missions, charity, and discipleship, focusing on unreached communities and youth, all under the TCE Council's direction to advance the Gospel with impact and unity.

The Elderly Ministry focuses on caring for the older members of our congregation. We organize events like high teas and a special Christmas dinner to give them a chance to relax, connect with one another, and enjoy time with volunteers.

The Worship Team brings worship to life with a variety of worship music, hymns, and contemporary worship, uniting the church in praise and creating a vibrant space to connect with God through music.

The Service committee exists to plan and organise services, other events and courses to help our church grow in faith, depth, and service. Under the leadership of the Pastor, this team prayerfully contributes to the preparation of worship services and other discipleship programmes or teaching courses. Working alongside (but distinct from) the Church Council, this committee serves as a vision-shaping group — helping the congregation to worship deeply, grow spiritually, and serve faithfully.

Children, Youth and Young Adults Ministries

Stepping Stone Team (0-4 years old) care for little ones during the service, offering a safe, joyful space with songs, stories, snacks, and crafts—making sure kids are loved, engaged, and growing in faith while having fun!

KidzChurch Team (4-11 years old) lead a fun, faith-filled program during Sunday services (except All-Age Sundays and school holidays) with worship, games, crafts, small group discussions, Bible time and prayer—helping kids grow spiritually, creatively, and in community.

In 1Tim4Twelve Team (12-13 years old), we mentor younger youth by modeling Christlike living, inspiring them to grow in character and faith as they build a strong foundation for life.

In **TYDE (14-18 years old),** we guide older youth with mentorship and support, helping them grow in faith, build community, and confidently navigate life as resilient Christian young adults.

LIFT (Life in Fellowship and Truth, Age 18 and above) vision is to create vibrant community of young adults who grow in their relationship with God, support each other through life's challenges and share the Gospel. We aim to deepen our understanding of God's word and foster strong Christian values.

Prayer Team

The Prayer Team is a group of volunteers who provide intercessory prayer during church services and offer personal prayer for individuals after the service. If you have a heart to pray for others and create space for God to move, this is a powerful way to serve.

Beamer Team sets up and runs the Open-LP system each Sunday, ensuring smooth, distraction-free worship and enhancing the service through tech and teamwork.

Sound & AV Team sets up the microphones, instrument connections, sound systems and makes necessary adjustment to ensure the sound enables us to enjoy the music during worship and the sermons as well as recording the service for zoom.

The **Website and Editorial Team** looks after the gathering and publishing content on the website and email newsletter.

Scripture Reader Team- It's an opportunity to serve God through preparing for the assigned scriptures and reading His Words with a clear voice during the services.

Practical Help Team offers support Trinity Church members with meals and practical help during times like new babies, illness, or surgery. Volunteers are contacted as needs arise. Cleaning Team ensures behind-thescenes work keeping our church welcoming. While cell groups often volunteer, we also need dedicated volunteers to help on other weeks.


